All RowAmerica Greenwich junior athletes are expected to consistently demonstrate the highest levels of conduct, sportsmanship and behavior while representing the club. Parents and athletes are required to sign the Code of Conduct form each year.

As a member of the RowAmerica Greenwich junior program an athlete recognizes that he/she is a representative of RowAmerica Greenwich at the boathouse, at regattas, and in their community. As a result the athlete is expected to be a role model at all times and to take responsibility for his/her actions.

- The use of alcohol, tobacco and illegal substances is prohibited at all times during the season. Use of such substances on club grounds or while representing RowAmerica Greenwich at a regatta will result in immediate dismissal.
- Inappropriate behavior (such illegal acts, unsportsmanlike-like conduct, theft, fighting, and vandalism) is prohibited. Illegal acts while on club grounds or while representing RowAmerica Greenwich at a regatta will result in immediate dismissal.
- Athletes will at all times act with good sportsmanship towards both teammates and competitors as well as act responsibly and respectfully towards other club members, the boathouse and the equipment.

Athletes who violate the Code of Conduct will incur the following consequences: First Offense:

The first violation will be a warning. Any RowAmerica Greenwich coach or any staff member can issue warnings. Staff members issuing warnings must inform the head coach. A meeting with the athlete and their parents will be requested by the head coach.

Second Offense:

The second violation will result in an immediate dismissal from the program, without refund. If a coach or staff member judges that a violation is sufficiently dangerous or improper, they can dismiss an athlete from the program without a first warning and without refund.

Code of Conduct for Early Morning Practices

- Each student is reminded that the club has residential neighbors whom reside near the club grounds.
- Common courtesy and neighborly etiquette is demanded at all times.
- No music outside the confines of the clubhouse.
- No car door slamming upon drop off / pick up of students.
- Talking between students to be at levels of normal person to person volumes while in parking lot or on boat docks.
- No horse play or social gatherings in parking lot or on docks.
- Keep cell phones in vibrate mode or switched off.

Athletes who violate the Code of Conduct for Early Morning Practices will incur the following consequences:

First Offense:

The first violation will be a warning. Any RowAmerica Greenwich coach or any staff member can issue warnings. Staff members issuing warnings must inform the head coach and athlete's parents.

Second Offense:

The second violation will result in another warning. A meeting with the athlete and their parents will be requested by the head coach. Potential suspension of club privileges may result upon completion of the meeting

Third Offense:

The third violation will result in an immediate dismissal from the program, without refund. If a coach or staff member judges that a violation is sufficiently dangerous or improper, they can dismiss an athlete from the program without a first warning and without refund.

This agreement shall remain in effect for one year. Violations of these policies, other rules set forth in the Parent/Athlete Handbook or rules presented to the athletes during the season may result in suspension or dismissal from the program without a refund.
